

Inspiration and Design Concept



The interior design for the entryway in this historic home embraces a soft tetradic color scheme of green, red, blue, and orange, drawn directly from the artistry of the original tile work found in the vestibule. The chosen palette and repeated biophilic motifs not only provide unity but celebrate the property’s heritage and introduce a harmonious sophistication to the space. A large inglenook fireplace is the focal point of the entryway. The mirror found over the mantel reflects light both from the antique luminaires and sunlight that filters in through the vestibule’s original leaded glass windows. A custom finish in the niches offer rich texture and highlight the architectural details. Carefully selected fabrics and flowers enhance the interplay between natural and decorative elements while area rugs provide softness underfoot. These rugs balance the dark millwork and floors while incorporating the creamy white color of the walls which are bathed in Sherwin-Williams’ “Alabaster” paint. This integration of lively, naturalistic motifs and color creates an environment that honors the home’s historical roots while providing a fresh, dynamic space that renews the past with elegance.


